

Technics Voice Editing (Boosting Voices two methods)

To make a voice louder on Technics Keyboards, select the voice to be altered/edited, then press, **Program Menus – Sound Edit – Tone Edit**, now this voice may have one to four Tones assigned to it, 1st to 4th now choose the level button under the screen, and raise the level of all the assigned **Tones**, until you are happy with the result. Now name and save it to memory, you will have a louder Right Hand Voice.

Equalizer Setting

A similar result may also be, achieved by boosting the setting of the **Equalizer**; this will apply to the **overall volume** of the Keyboard, then lowering the **APC/Sequencer Volume**.

The Method as follows, press **Program Menus – Reverb & Effects – Equalizer** now select **Flat** and raise the **Gain** to about 6.5 to 7bB you can also change the **FC (Hz)** to suit you room environment, but you don't need to do this. Finally make sure the **EQ : ON** is (lit in red). To lock this setting press exit twice now press, **Customise – Data Protection** and set the **Total Equalizer** to **ON** and **Ok** it, a **Completed !** message pops up. Now to complete this setup lower the **APC/Sequencer Volume**, and all **Right & Left** Voices will be louder against the backings.
