

Transpose Assign (two methods).

The Yamaha Keyboard's perform the transpose differently from other makes, and so if you wish to use this function to your performance, you must set it to "Keyboard, it will take effect and then revert to the original pitch.

This because it can be assigned, to three other functions of transposing, namely **Keyboard**, **Song**, and **Master**, its default setting being "**Master**."

If you want to play along with a song that's in a different or difficult, key you would set the assign to **Song**.

Also Note the transpose does not take effect until you play the next note, or chord, so take your hands off then play then together, this will give a very smooth change of key.

Note, once the settings below described have been made, it will remain this way until the user changes it.

Method 1

1. So to set it, press the (FUNCTION) button.
2. Now press button (D), to select (CONTROLLER) from the screen.
3. Press the (TAB TYROS 2 or {NEXT} button on other models) or the KEYBOARD/PANEL display.
4. Press button B this will scroll down and highlight TRANSPOSE ASSIGN
5. Press button 4 or 5 to select KEYBOARD from the other options.
6. Pressing the exit button twice gets you back to the main screen.

Method 2

There is a shortcut of the above, and that is if you are on the "normal screen" press, **DIRECT ACCESS** button (Screen bottom left), then either of **TRANSPOSE** buttons (+ -), you will go straight to the assign page, press button 4 or 5, to select **KEYBOARD** and It's done.

Now having mentioned the **DIRECT ACCESS** button this tool is really useful, and nearly all Keyboard functions can be accessed in this manner, this short cut gives you instant access to lots functions, easily and quickly, I use it all the time.

Just for completeness the **MIXING CONSOLE** has a page called **TUNE** that shows the **Portamento Time**, **Pitch Bend Range**, **Octave**, and **Detuning** settings, of all the **Right 1, 2, 3**, and, **Left Voices**, and also shows the **TRANSPOSE** settings for, **KEYBOARD**, **SONG**, and **MASTER**, so you can see all their relative settings at once. These may all be changed on here! So it's very versatile Page.
